5-K Elk Run/Walk

Held Saturday morning at 8 A.M. Early registration is \$15 per person until September 15, 2008 and \$20 the day of the event. All proceeds benefit the Youth Scholarship Fund at Cecil College. The race will begin and end at Cecil College, Elkton Station. Free t-shirts will be given to the first 200 registered participants. Prizes will be awarded to runners in top 3 overall and the top 2 Masters and male/female age groups.

Pretty Baby Contest

The Elkton Pretty Baby Contest is held on Saturday morning and is open to new-borns through 3 years old. The cost is \$3 for pre-registration or \$5 the day of the event. Winners of each age group will receive a ribbon and a savings bond.

Miss Fall Fest Contest

Held on Saturday afternoon at 11 P.M. with preregistration beginning at 10 A.M. Young girls between the ages of 12 - 14 (Jr. Miss Fall Fest) and 15 - 17 (Miss Fall Fest) will compete for the titles. The girls are voted on their poise, personality, presentation, and public speaking. The Miss Fall Fest Contest is not a Beauty Pageant but a contest for the most well rounded young lady. Contestants will be asked a fishbowl question on a current event or topic that relates to the world today. The Miss Fall Fest Contest will accept pre-registration as well as registration the day of the event.

Elkton Idol

Elkton's own talent showcase held at the Main Street Stage from 1 - 3 P.M. on Saturday. 20 Contestants will compete to become the Elkton Idol. The cost for the contest is \$10 per performer or group. The winner will receive \$200 and a trophy. Contestants are asked to have 2 song choices in case of a tie. All Vocalist must have back up music (karaoke only please) clearly marked with performer's name and song selection on the CD and must give a copy to the event organizers by September 11th to be placed on a master cd for the event. Each performer will have only 5 minutes to perform. For musical performances, the drums and P.A. system only will be provided. FIREFIGHTER COMBAT CHALLENGE

Hailed by ESPN as "The Toughest 2 Minutes" in Sports," the Challenge is a competition with a purpose: it's about performing one of the most dangerous jobs safer and better. These competitors are in every respect, world-class athletes.

The Firefighter Combat Challenge provides a snapshot of one of the most physically demanding and respected of occupations. It is an intense, spirited competition that demonstrates to the viewing public the nature of the job, and no job is more dependent upon the physical prowess of its work force. The Challenge is an urgent race against time, and time is the mortal enemy of all firefighters as fire doubles in size every 90 seconds.

Wearing "full bunker gear" and a Scott Air-Pak(r), pairs of firefighter's race head-to-head on a linked series of five grueling fire-related tasks. Competitors must climb a five story tower while carrying a 45-lb high-rise pack, then hoist a 45-lb hose roll to the top of the tower. Next they descend to the base of the tower where they simulate chopping by driving a 160-lb steel beam a distance of five feet using a 9-lb. shot mallet. They then zigzag 140-ft. between hydrants to the fourth station, where they advance an attack hose a distance of 75-ft. Finally, the competitors must drag a life-sized, 175-lb "victim" a distance of 100-ft to the finish line (the world record is under 80 seconds).

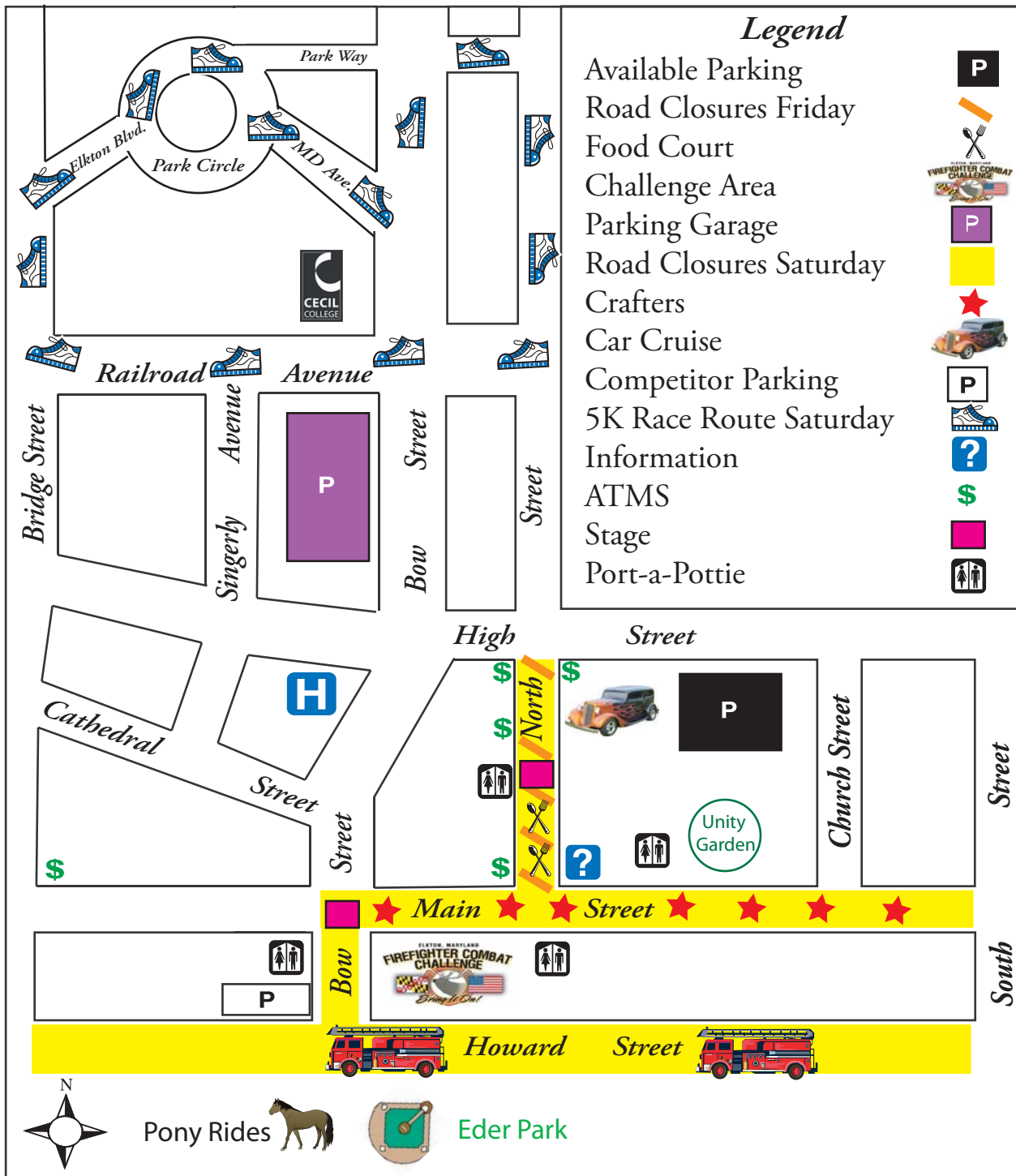
